Health Care Certificates

he INS has finally issued regulations regarding the issuance of health care certificates to physical therapists. This certification, which is required under a 1996 immigration law, ensures that foreign-trained health care workers have the same training... education and licensure as similarly employed U.S. workers.

Health care workers, other than physicians, cannot obtain their green card unless a health care certification known as Visa Screen certificate is issued to them by an authorized credentialing agency.

The INS was prompted to that can apply for the certifi-Health care workers, other cate because of the sustained certification the Department of Labor, the number of job openings for this occupation continues to remain high. Under the H-1B program, therapists have the second highest number of job openings and physical therapists comprise the biggest component of this occupation.

It is not known at this time when the other health care workers like medical technologists and physician's assistants will be able to apply. To date, there are thousands of health care workers who have not obtained their green card because they have not been issued the health care certificate.

One of the requirements of the certificate is competence in oral and written English. Physical therapists must take the English Tests administered by the Educational testing Service (ETS). They must obtain the following scores: Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL): paperbased 560, computer-based -220; Test of Written English (TWE): 4.5; Test of Spoken English (TSE): 50.

The Michigan English Language Assessment Battery (MELAB) is not an appropriate test for physical therapists or occupational therapists. It is, however, an acceptable test for nurses.
